Once you've got your outline, you are in a position to put the details together. This step seems inappropriate, especially for shorter or more informal communications but like any other skill, exercise of your writing skills is necessary for improved quality of communication. Remember that spoken and written language has syntax and grammar just like computer languages, your two major issues to watch for are:

1. SYNTAX ERROR

All of those lessons on word choice, grammar and spelling matter.

2. COMPILATION ERROR

Even when the individual sentences are ok, the entire body of the message must be complete. Do you have a beginning, a middle and an end?
