The process of annotation serves two main purposes:

1. sources

Whether it is a formal presentation or an informal discussion, you must provide references for any material you are using that someone else developed.

This isn't just about "academic honesty", it's about not being a the kind of douchebag who steals ideas and takes credit.

2. notes to self

Whether you are building a formal presentation or a set of talking points, remembering that how you say it is as important as what you say and in the case of a slide deck, what you need to remind you while you're talking is probably not what is on the screen.

This is the music for your lyrics - the notation in the score informs the musician and contributes to what the audience perceives without using words.
